

AGRIWARE PRIVACY POLICY

To protect your privacy, we provide this privacy policy (the "Privacy Policy") which explains AgriWare's information practices including the way your information is collected and used from the registration and use of AgriWare's products and services.

1. WHY AGRIWARE COLLECTS PERSONAL INFORMATION

AgriWare collects and uses Personal Information (as defined below) to make AgriWare's products more secure and easier to use and to help us provide products and services to you.

2. PERSONAL INFORMATION

When you use AgriWare's products, we may collect information such as your name, your company name, your job title, your address including city, state and the zip code, email address, telephone number, the date and time of use, your internet protocol (IP) address, browser type, browser language, operating system, domain names, access times, web response times, payment information, your billing and physical addresses as such may relate to AgriWare and/or any other information in connection with any of the products we provide (collectively "Personal Information"). We may review Personal Information at any time and without notice. We may also retain Personal Information even after you stop being a user of an Agriware product in order to maintain the integrity of our data systems. If you choose not to provide Personal Information when requested, you may not be able to use AgriWare's products.

3. RIGHT TO PERSONAL INFORMATION

By providing us with Personal Information, you expressly consent to the use of the Personal Information in accordance with the terms of this Privacy Policy and give us a perpetual, transferable, licensable, sublicensable, assignable, sellable, royalty-free, worldwide right and license to any Personal Information you are the rightful owner or licensee of. In the event we sell all or a portion of our business and/or assets, we reserve the right to transfer Personal Information to the purchaser as part of that acquisition.

4. ACCESS TO PERSONAL INFORMATION

You may review and update your Personal Information at any time through the appropriate "Edit profile" sections of an application or by emailing support@agri-ware.com.

5. VERIFICATION

For your protection and to assist us in preventing fraud and unauthorized use, we reserve the right to verify certain Personal Information.

6. PROTECTING YOUR INFORMATION

AgriWare implements precautions to protect your Personal Information. Your data is stored in password-controlled servers with limited access. When you place orders online that include payment information you will be utilizing a secure server layer (“SSL”) that encrypts the data before it's sent over the Internet. You should take care in disclosing your Personal Information in areas of AgriWare's products that may be accessible by others. It is your responsibility to monitor your account. Passwords are stored in an encrypted manner that prevents anyone, including AgriWare from recovering passwords. Passwords can only be reset by the account owner or a system administrator. If suspected that a password or user name have been compromised you must change your password immediately. Your use of AgriWare's products may also be subject to other third party policies that may differ materially from this Privacy Policy. We are not responsible for such policies and it is your responsibility to make yourself familiar with them.

7. DISCLOSURE TO THIRD PARTIES

We do not share Personal Information with third parties except to the extent necessary to fulfill or verify an information or as may be required to best provide our products. We will only provide those third parties Personal Information they need to deliver the service and/or product. We will disclose your personal information, without notice, if such disclosure is necessary to: (i) satisfy any applicable law, regulation, legal process or enforceable governmental request; (ii) enforce applicable terms of use or other contract rights, including investigation of potential violations thereof or protect and defend the rights or interests of AgriWare, (iii) detect, prevent, or otherwise address fraud, security or technical issues (including but not limited to the abuse of our services by spamming, use of our services to attack other systems or to gain unauthorized access to any other system), or (iv) protect against imminent harm to the rights, property or safety of AgriWare.

8. USE OF BROWSER COOKIES

Following the practice of most web applications, AgriWare uses cookies to manage user interaction with the application's user interface(“UI”). A cookie is a file that is placed in the memory or storage of your device by a server. The purpose of a cookie is to inform the server that you are using or have used a certain service. Information gathered through cookies and web server logs may include, but not limited to, the date and time while using our service. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you and you have the ability to accept or decline Cookies. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to use the products. We may use cookies without any additional notice to you.

POLICY UPDATES AND CHANGES We are dedicated to continually improve AgriWare's products and services because of these improvements we reserve the right to change, modify, add, or remove portions of this Privacy Policy at any time simply by posting the revised Privacy Policy on AgriWare's website, and without any other notice to you. The revised Privacy Policy will become effective immediately upon its posting. By visiting AgriWare's website, you hereby acknowledge that your visit and/or use now and any dispute that may have arisen over privacy in the past or in the future is subject to the most current Privacy Policy in effect.
